Special Called Council Meeting to Canvass Municipal Option Election Results

The Rainsville City Council met at 12:00 noon at the Agri Center on November 12, 2014, for canvassing the Municipal Option Election Results. The following members were present: Mayor Nick Jones. Councilmembers: Joey Graham, Brandon Freeman and Rodger Lingerfelt. Absent: Councilmember: David Holt, Melissa Ledbetter and City Attorney: Dara Patterson.

With proper notice being given Mayor Jones called the meeting to order and called the roll.

The clerk delivered a tally sheet, **Canvass Resolution #11-12-14**, the election results, and the provisional ballot results, returned by the Board of Registrars to mayor and council.

The council reviewed the PB3 envelope returned from the Board of Registrars, and separated the envelopes indicating the votes to be counted from the votes not to be counted; opened the Provisional Ballot Box and called the voters' name for votes to be counted; opened the PB2 envelopes of those voters and extracted the PB1 secrecy envelope; opened the secrecy envelopes of those voters containing the ballot and read the results and recorded those votes on the tally sheets. There were two provisional votes properly counted and the provisional vote results were as follower's one yes vote and one no vote on the "Dry to "Wet" Election. The Final Total Results were: **Yes: 742 No: 771** and were posted at city hall.

A Motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to pass and adopt **RESOLUTION #11-12-13 CANVASS MUNICIPAL OPTION ELECTION RESULTS**. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Lingerfelt to adjourn at 12:10 pm. Motion carried unanimously.
