Item #3. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to move the council meetings to the Agri-Center starting at 5:30 pm with workshop starting at 5:00 pm effective January 2014. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to pay the monthly bills as presented by the city treasurer. Motion carried with all in favor.
