**Mayor Lingerfelt called the meeting to order and called the roll.**

**Item #1.** A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Taheri to authorize Swan Plumbing to replumb the sewer pump at Stiefel House location for a sum of \$1360.00. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #3.** A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Byrum **TO PASS AND ADOPT RESOLUTION 11-20-2017 TO SURPLUS A FRIGIDAIRE REFRIDGERATOR AT THE TOM BEVILL CENTER. Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #4.** A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to authorize the repair of a thermal imaging camera in the Fire Department for a sum of \$1,143.77. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #5.** A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to place the podium in a fixed position in the center of the Council Chamber where anyone wishing to address the Mayor and Council will stand. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #6.** A motion was made by Stiefel to appoint a three (3) man committee to include himself, Mayor, and Councilman Taheri to address issues with the State concerning the current road/concrete barriers project. **Motion died due to lack of a second.**

A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Byrum to pay the monthly bills. **Motion carried with opposition from Stiefel.**
