The Rainsville City Council met in Regular Session on April 17, 2017 at the Rainsville Municipal Annex with the following members present: Mayor: Rodger Lingerfelt. Council Members—Marshall Stiefel, Bejan Taheri, Rickey Byrum, Brandon Freeman, Derek Rosson.

Mayor Lingerfelt called the meeting to order and called the roll.

Item #1. A motion was made by Taheri and seconded by Rosson to authorize the Mayor to sign an agreement with the Ambassador Company and authorize a payment of \$ 854.00 for a period of two (2) years to distribute books to every 1st and 4th grader at Plainview and Cornerstone Christian Academy. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #2. A motion was made by Byrum and seconded by Rosson to authorize the Mayor to contract Kim Erwin with Morton & Associates, Inc. for grant assistance to resurface Ranch Road through ADECA. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #3. A motion was made by Taheri and seconded by Freeman **TO PASS AND ADOPT RESOLUTION #04-17-2017 (A) PROVIDING FOR THE CITY OF RAINSVILLE PARTICIPATION IN THE “SALES TAX HOLIDAY” AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT NO. 2017-120 IN JULY OF 2017.** **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #4. A motion was made by Stiefel and seconded by Freeman to authorize the purchase of a 2014 Ford F150 Pickup Truck from the State Bid List for the Sewer Department for a sum of \$ 16,975.00 to be paid out of the Sewer Fund. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #5. A motion was made by Stiefel and seconded by Freeman to purchase two (2) Desktop Computers for City Hall from Genesis Computers for a sum of \$1789.90. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #6. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Rosson **TO PASS AND ADOPT RESOLUTION #04-17-2017 (C) DECLARING PERSONAL PROPERTY SURPLUS AND ORDERING DISPOSITION OF SAME. 2007 FORD LGT CONV T VIN: 1FTPX14VX7NA68065.** **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #7. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Stiefel to hire Brad Willingham as a Grade IV Operator at the Waste Water Treatment Plant at the starting pay on the pay scale. **Motion carried with Rosson abstaining due to family relation to the hire.**

Item #8. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to authorize the hire of Chris Phillips in the Police Department at the six (6) month rate on the pay scale. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #9. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to accept the retirement of Charles Coffen in the Police Department effective May 1, 2017. Last day on the job will be April 16, 2017. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #10. A motion was made by Byrum and seconded by Freeman to authorize the purchase of a 2012 Ford F150 Pickup Truck from the State Bid List for the Sanitation Department for a sum of \$16,450.00 to be paid out of the Sanitation Account. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #11. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman **TO PASS AND ADOPT RESOLUTION #04-17-2017 (B) DECLARING PERSONAL PROPERTY SURPLUS AND ORDERING DISPOSITION OF SAME. 2000 FORD EXPLORER VIN: 1FMZU71X7YUB75703.** **Motion carried with all in favor.**
