

**RESOLUTION 12-07-2015**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING  
PERSONAL PROPERTY SURPLUS  
AND ORDERING DISPOSITION OF THE SAME**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Rainsville, Alabama has certain items of personal property which is no longer needed or useful for public purpose or municipal purposes; and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-43-56 of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to dispose of the unneeded personal property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE CITY COUNCIL OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That the following personal property owned by the City of Rainsville, Alabama is not needed and is no longer useful for public or municipal purposes:

40 Snowflake Christmas Lights

**Section 2:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to dispose of the above personal property by one or more of the following means: advertising and receiving bids, public auction, or private sale. Said property shall be sold at such price as the Mayor determines to be a fair price in view of the condition of the property. Notwithstanding, the Mayor may discard any of the items on the list, which he determines is inoperable, and has no salvage value. The Mayor is further authorized to transfer said property to the purchaser, including executing a certificate of title and other documentation required for this purpose.
