REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING:

The Rainsville City Council met in regular session on February 3, 2014, at 5:30 pm at the Agri – Center with the following members present: Mayor Nick Jones. Councilmembers: Joey Graham, Melissa Ledbetter, Brandon Freeman, Rodger Lingerfelt. City Attorney: Dara Patterson. Absent: David Holt.

Mayor Jones called the meeting to order and called the roll.

A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Ledbetter to approve the January 20th, 2014 regular council meeting minutes as presented and read by the Clerk. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #1. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to replace the Maintenance/Mowing position on the city's pay scale with the caveat that it has two employees in that slot receiving pay under that particular pay scale. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #2. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to move our next regular council meeting from February 17th to Tuesday, February 18th due to President Day Holiday. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #3. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Freeman to allow Debbie Lanier, City Treasurer to issue a check of \$500.00 to the 501(3)(c) sponsor for the Imagination Library from the Special Account that was set up. Motion carried with all in favor. This bank account will remain open.

Item #4. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Ledbetter to accept the following resignations from the Youth Activity Board: Steve Bowman, Scott Kirk and Keith Williams, due to the fact their terms were up. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #5. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Graham to appoint the following members to the Youth activity Board: Matt Whitfield, Heath Lingerfelt and Monty Price. These are five year terms. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #6. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to pay Jerry Hartline \$900.00 for building a pad for the new playground equipment at the Field of Dreams. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #7. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to have Williams Fence place fencing around the new playground equipment at the Field of Dreams. Cost \$6,125.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #8. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to appoint the following summer workers for the Field of Dreams: Katie Bryant, Tina Broyles, Kelly Bunch, Leisa Bunch, Ben Coots, Alana Fobbus, Natalie Graham, Abigail Hampton, Macy Laney, Joey Markowski, Amy Smith, Anita Smith, Allie Williams, and Savannah Willingham. All will be paid minimum wage except for four who will be paid .25 hr. more. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Ledbetter to pay the monthly bills as presented by the city treasurer. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to adjourn at 5:48 pm. Motion carried with all in favor.
