**Item #1.** A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Graham to empower the Mayor to sign a Lease Agreement from Terry Taylor using his property known as the Rainsville Garment Property during the Freedom Fest Event on June 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Item #2.** A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Holt to empower the Mayor to sign the RDS/Tax Revenue Enhancement Agreement for Business License Discovery/Recovery. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Item #3.** A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Lingerfelt to move Derrick Huskey from a firefighter's position to the Grant Recruitment & Retention Coordinator and post for an opening for firefighter's position. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Item #4.** A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to purchase an ad with the Plainview Touchdown Club for \$125.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Item #5.** A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Graham to hire Sam Contraction on an hourly rate to make repairs to the Police Department due to a water problem. This will be paid out of the Government Capital Improvement Fund. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Item #6.** A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to purchase eleven gear racks for the fire department in the amount of \$3,063.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Item #7.** A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Graham to purchase five radios for the fire department in the amount of \$2,070.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Lingerfelt to pay the monthly bills as presented by the city treasurer. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Lingerfelt to adjourn at 6:10 pm. Motion carried with all in favor.
