REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING:

The Rainsville City Council met in regular session on July 7, 2014, at 5:30 pm at the Agri-Center with the following members present: Mayor Pro-Tem Rodger Lingerfelt. Councilmembers: Joey Graham, David Holt, Melissa Ledbetter and Brandon Freeman. City Attorney: Dara Patterson. Absent: Mayor Nick Jones.

Mayor Pro-Tem Lingerfelt called the meeting to order and called the roll.

A motion was made by Holt and seconded by Freeman to approve the minutes as presented with the following request from Councilmember Ledbetter. Melissa asked that it be noted that in our May 19, 2014 minutes (Item #5) that the council requested the Mayor to submit a financial report to the council in June and December and that this policy was not met in June. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #1. A motion was made by Freeman to purchase a 2015 Chevrolet Suburban for the fire department in the amount of \$38,346.06 to be paid out of the fire department funds and due to a lack of a second, motion failed.

Item #2. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to empower Wayne Young to make repairs to the library at a cost of \$4,365.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Lingerfelt to pay the monthly bills as presented by the city treasurer. Motion carried with all in favor.
