REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING:

The Rainsville City Council met in regular session on September 3, 2013, at 6:00 pm at the Rainsville Fire Hall with the following members present: Mayor Nick Jones. Councilmembers: Rodger Lingerfelt, Brandon Freeman, Joey Freeman, David Holt and Melissa Ledbetter.

Mayor Jones called the meeting to order and called the roll.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to approve the minutes of the August 19th, 2013, regular council meeting as presented and read by the clerk. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #1. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Graham to accept the low bid of \$72,488.00 from Whitaker Contracting, Inc. for paving of the TBEC parking lot. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #2. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Freeman to accept the quote of \$5,340.00 from Iven Harville to paint the inside of the TBEC. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #3. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Lingerfelt to purchase a large sign from Cryer Signs at a cost of \$14,995.00 for the TBEC if it is in compliance with the city's sign ordinance. Voting yea: Ledbetter, Lingerfelt, Holt, Freeman. Voting nay: Jones, Graham. Motion carried.

Item #4. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Freeman to have the fire department apply for a Federal Grant to hire six firefighters. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Ledbetter to pay the monthly bills as presented by the city treasurer. Motion carried with all in favor.

At 6:15 pm, a motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to go into executive session to discuss ongoing litigation. Motion carried unanimously.

At 6:49 pm, by report of Mayor, a motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Ledbetter to return to regular session with no action taken. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to adjourn at 6:50 pm. Motion carried with all in favor.
