She stated if the city would pay for replacing one sign the Beautification Board would pay for the other two and the pole.

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING:

The Rainsville City Council met in regular session on January 5, 2015, at 5:30 pm at the Agri Center with the following members present: Mayor Nick Jones. Councilmembers: Joey Graham, David Holt, Melissa Ledbetter, Brandon Freeman and Rodger Lingerfelt. City Attorney: Dara Patterson.

Mayor Jones called the meeting to order and called the roll.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to dispense with the reading of the minutes for the December 15, 2014, regular council meeting and approve then as presented by the clerk. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #1. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to purchase 100 new garbage cans and 28 new dumpster lids for the sanitation department. Cost \$6,775.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #2. A motion was made by Holt and seconded by Graham to pay Lance Kittle Repair \$1,396.74 for repairs made to the dump truck at the WWTP. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #3. A motion was made by Holt and seconded by Ledbetter to pay Lance Kittle Repair \$700.00 to repair another truck at the WWTP with a cap of \$1,000.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #4. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Lingerfelt for the city to pay for replacing one city limit sign and the Beautification Board pay for replacing the other two city limits signs and the extra poles. Total cost \$3,950.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to pay the monthly bills as presented by the City Treasurer. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Lingerfelt to adjourn at 5:40 pm, Motion carried unanimously.
