**Mayor Lingerfelt called the meeting to order and called the roll.**

**Item #1.** A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to issue a Proclamation proclaiming the month of February as Educational Career Tech Month. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #2.** A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to promote Derrick Summerford to Captain in the Fire Dept at the starting rate on the pay scale. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #5.** A motion was made by Byrum and seconded by Rosson to purchase a safe from DeKalb Farmers Coop for City Hall at a sum of \$999.00. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #6.** A motion was made by Byrum and seconded by Freeman to purchase a total of (3) street lights—Scott/Everett, Skaggs/Lingerfelt, Skaggs/Marshall. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #7.** A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Byrum to authorize Dabbs & Sons Drywall to repair walls in (2) meeting rooms at the Library for a sum of \$2200.00. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #8.** A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Taheri to authorize Sand Mountain Tinting to tint the windows on the front of City Hall for a sum of \$1546.20. **Motion carried with opposition from Stiefel.**

**Item #10.** A motion was made by Taheri and seconded by Rosson to hire Eric Tidmore as a Patrolman at the Police Department starting at the yearly rate on the pay scale. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #11.** A motion was made by Taheri and seconded by Stiefel to post a patrolman position in the Police Department on the City's webpage. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #12.** A motion was made by Taheri and seconded by Byrum to hire Christian Ranstall as a Part-Time Dispatcher at the starting rate on the pay scale. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #13.** A motion was made by Taheri and seconded by Byrum to hire Caitlin East as a Part-Time Dispatcher at the starting rate on the pay scale. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #14.** A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman authorizing the purchase and installation of a new phone and internet system from Farmers Telephone Coop for a sum of \$4,000.00. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #15.** A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to empower the Mayor to sign the plats for the Graceful Acres Subdivision. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #16.** A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Rosson to authorize a sponsorship of \$500 for the Laronda Nichols 5k Run supporting a domestic violence shelter that serves DeKalb, Cherokee, and Marshall Counties. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

**Item #17.** A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to authorize Richard Gibson and David Snay to attend a Revenue Training Conference in Tuscaloosa, Al on April 8, 2017. **Motion carried with all in favor.**
