REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING:

The Rainsville City Council met in regular session on April 15, 2013, at 6:00 pm at the Rainsville Fire Hall with the following members present: Mayor Nick Jones. Councilmembers: Rodger Lingerfelt, Brandon Freeman and Melissa Ledbetter. Absent: David Holt and Joey Graham.

Mayor Jones called the meeting to order and called the roll.

A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Freeman to approve the minutes of the April 1st, 2013, regular council meeting as read by the clerk. Motion carried with all in favor.

6:00 pm -- BID OPENING FOR A 1997 MACK TRUCK AND 10 ROLL OFF CONTAINERS

Item #1. With proper notice being given about adverting for bids for a 1997 Mack Truck and 10 roll off containers, the following sealed bid was received: Priority Waste total price for truck and containers \$60,000.00. After a discussion, a motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Lingerfelt to accept this bid from Priority Waste as presented. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #2. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to empower the Mayor to sign on behalf of the city for a mobile home to be place on Garret Street for Tracie Edmondson. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #3. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to appoint Melissa Ledbetter as the Voting Delegate to represent the city at the Alabama Annual League Convention in Montgomery. Voting yea: Jones, Freeman, Lingerfelt. Abstained: Ledbetter. Motion carried.

Item #4. **RESOLUTION #04-15-13 A RESOLUTION DECLARING PERSONAL PROPERTY SURPLUS AND ORDERING DISPOSITION OF SAME** was presented, after a discussion, a motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Freeman to pass and adopt this Resolution as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Item #5. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Lingerfelt to appoint Skeeter Logan to the Rainsville Planning Commission Board to replace Chris Bowman who resigned. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #6. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to accept the resignation of Pat Cagle from the Mental Retardation Board. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #7. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Ledbetter to appoint Kelly Broyles to the Mental Retardation Board to replace Pat Cagle. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #8. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to purchase a Super Z Hustler Mowing Machine for the Park and Rec. department from DeKalb Farmers Coop. Cost: \$9,000.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Ledbetter to hire the following as part time temporary summer workers at the Field of Dreams: Allie Bryan, Katie Bryant, Kelly Bunch, Leisa Bunch, Tina Broyles, Colton Campbell, Dylan Clark, Natalie Graham, Abigail Hampton, Kaci Kirk, Macy Laney, Tyler Ledford, Anita Smith, Allie Williams, Kyle Williams, Savannah Willingham and Cody Coots for the pool. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Lingerfelt to pay the monthly bills as presented. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to adjourn at 6:10 pm. Motion carried unanimously.
