PUBLIC HEARING
June 5, 2017

With proper notice being given, the Rainsville City Council held a Public Hearing on the 5th day of June, 2017, at 5:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Rainsville Municipal Annex with the following members Present: Mayor- Rodger Lingerfelt. Councilmembers: Marshall Stiefel,, Rickey Byrum, Brandon Freeman, Derek Rosson. Absent: Bejan Taheri

Mayor Lingerfelt called the Public Hearing to order.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to address vacating the alleyways in three (3) specific locations in the city of Rainsville, AL. Hicks Dr., Bowman Way, and Mims Ave.

Mayor Lingerfelt opened the floor for discussion and asked if anyone was present to speak on behalf of vacating the alleyways.

James Hicks addressed the Mayor and Council with his concerns associated with vacating the alleyway on Hicks Drive. and preferred the situation be left in the current status.

Bonnie Croft and Sharon Marshall were also present and expressed opposition to vacating the alleyway on Hicks Drive.

Cecil Frees was present in opposition and questioned the expense of the process of vacating the alleyways on Hicks Drive.

Charlie Glover spoke on behalf of the alleyway on Hicks Drive.

Kevin Black was present in support of vacating the alleyway on Mims Ave.

Patricia Edmonds was present in support of vacating the alleyway on Mims Ave.

There was no one present regarding Bowman Way.

The Mayor and Council collectively decided to re-address the issue in another Public Hearing on July 3, 2017 and make a final decision at this time.

The Public Hearing was closed at 5:32 p.m.
