The Rainsville City Council met in Regular Session on June 5, 2017 at the Rainsville Municipal Annex with the following members present: Mayor: Rodger Lingerfelt. Council Members—Marshall Stiefel, Rickey Byrum, Brandon Freeman, Derek Rosson. Absent: Bejan Taheri

Mayor Lingerfelt called the meeting to order and called the roll.

Item #1. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Byrum **TO SUSPEND THE RULES FOR IMMEDIATE CONSIDERATION OF ORDINANCE 06-05-2017. MOTION CARRIED WITH A ROLL CALL VOTE. STIEFEL-YEA, BYRUM-YEA, FREEMAN-YEA, ROSSON-YEA.**

Item #2. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Byrum **TO PASS AND ADOPT ORDINANCE 06-05-2017 RE-APPOINTING JOHNATHON ANDREWS AND GARY BLEVINS TO THE EDUCATIONAL BUILDING AUTHORITY. MOTION CARRIED WITH A ROLL CALL VOTE. STIEFEL-YEA, BYRUM-YEA, FREEMAN-YEA, ROSSON YEA.**

Item #3. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Byrum **TO PASS AND ADOPT RESOLUTION 06-05-2017 (A) SETTING FORTH THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS AND SCHEDULE NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN EFFLUENT REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN THE NPDES PERMIT, AND TO PREVENT THE BYPASS AND OVERFLOW OF RAW SEWAGE WITHIN THE COLLECTION SYSTEM OR AT THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT. Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #4. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Byrum **TO PASS AND ADOPT RESOLUTION 06-05-2017 (B) TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND EMPOWER THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE RESOLUTION FOR UPCOMING PAVING PROJECTS THE CITY IS COORDINATING WITH THE STATE. Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #5. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Rosson to authorize a per diem of \$15 per meal (3) times per day with a cap of \$45.00 per day for City employees traveling to conferences. Employees who drive their own vehicles will be reimbursed for travel and gas upon their return from the conference. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #6. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to accept Jamey Chapman's resignation from the Police Department. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #7. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Byrum to hire Josh Hunter as a Patrolman in the Police Department starting at the 6-month rate on the pay scale. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #8. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to hire Luke Yarbrough PT to serve as an Animal Control employee at an hourly rate of \$12.50. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #9. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Byrum to hire Steve Davis PT in the Sanitation Department at an hourly rate of \$12.50. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #10. A motion was made by Byrum and seconded by Stiefel to hire Michael Peterson PT in the Sanitation Department at an hourly rate of \$12.50. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #11. A motion was made by Byrum and seconded by Freeman to purchase a concrete/asphalt saw for an approximate sum of \$2300.00. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #12. A motion was made by Byrum and seconded by Freeman to accept Gala Street, in the Orchard Subdivision, at

the recommendation of City Engineer, Sam Phillips. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #13. A motion was made by Freeman to accept Brannon Street into the City at the recommendation of City Engineer, Sam Phillips. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #14. A motion was made by Byrum and seconded by Stiefel to accept Robin Lane in the Maple Hill Subdivision into the City at the recommendation of City Engineer, Sam Phillips. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #15. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Byrum to hire Michael Phillips as the Assistant Manager at the Pool. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #16. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to accept the new contract with the Square Dancer's use of the Tom Bevill Center and authorize the Mayor to sign to lower the weekly rate from \$75 to \$65 and reserve the right for the City to retain use 3 times per calendar year if needed to serve a community purpose. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #17. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to promote Nick Knopps to night Sergeant. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #18. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Byrum to promote Stephen Malone to night Sergeant. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #19. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded Freeman to authorize the change of the rank structure in the Police Department listing Investigator above Sergeant. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #20. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to move Tim Devlin to School Resource officer for Plainview, Cornerstone Christian Academy, Candyland Daycare and the Mission Center. **Motion carried with all favor.**

Item #21. A motion was made by Rosson and seconded by Freeman to purchase 3 Chevrolet Tahoes for the Police Department from the State Bid List from Donohoo Chevrolet. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #22. A motion was made by Byrum and seconded by Freeman to authorize the Mayor to seek financing for the Road Paving Project until the State issues the grant to reimburse the funds. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Byrum to pay the monthly bills. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

A motion was made by Stiefel and seconded by Freeman to adjourn the meeting at 6:00 p.m. **Motion carried with all in favor.**
