Regular Council Meeting Monday 5:30 p.m.

The Rainsville City Council met in Regular Session on September 6, 2016, at the Rainsville Municipal Annex with the following members present: Mayor—Nick Jones. Council Members—Joey Graham, David Holt, Melissa Ledbetter, Brandon Freeman and Rodger Lingerfelt.

Mayor Jones called the meeting to order and called the roll.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Lingerfelt to approve and dispense with the reading of the minutes. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #1. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Ledbetter to accept the Zoning Board's recommendation and rezone the property on George Wallace from R-2 Low Density Residential to B-3 General Commercial District. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #2. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Ledbetter to empower the Mayor to sign the certification presented by Jerry Posey pertaining to The Pines Subdivision. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #3. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Lingerfelt to hire Anthony Austin as a Patrolman in the Police Dept effective 9-7, and authorize a sum of \$1000 to buy out his contract. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #4. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Lingerfelt to hire David Snay back as a fulltime Patrolman in the Police Dept effective 9-7 at the 1 year rate on the pay scale. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #5. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Lingerfelt to promote Kevin Smith to Investigator effective 9-7 and adjust his pay equal to the Sergeant's rate on the pay scale. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #6. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to authorize the purchase of fire prevention materials at the Fire Dept for an approximate sum of \$2000. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #7. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Ledbetter to authorize the repair of the ladder truck at the Fire Dept for a sum of \$200-225. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #8. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Ledbetter to authorize pump tests services to be performed on 5 trucks at the Fire Dept at a sum of \$750 per truck, to be paid out of the Fire Truck & Equipment Account. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #9. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Lingerfelt to authorize the purchase of Sparky for the Fire Dept for a sum of \$5000 to be reimbursed by a \$5000 donation from Representative Ledbetter. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #10. A motion was made by Holt and seconded by Ledbetter to set a date of 9-12 to conduct a Budget Workshop at 5:00 p.m. to be continued on 9-19 at 4:00 p.m. prior to the Regular Council Meeting if needed. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #11. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to authorize payment of an invoice for the WWTP to Kazmier for \$1,562.32 for the semi-annual calibration of flow meter certification and supplies. **Motion carried with all in favor.**

Item #12. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to pay the monthly bills.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to adjourn the meeting at 5:36 p.m. **Motion carried with all in favor.**
